What Helps (continued)...

- Opportunities to move
- Talking through ideas before writing
- Predictable routines
- Advance notice of changes

If you notice...

- Avoidance
- Frustration
- Shutting down
- Perfectionism
- Big emotions

It may mean...

- The task feels overwhelming
- My child is unsure where to begin.
- Sensory demands are high.
- Anxiety has taken over.
- They need connection before problem-solving
